

It is mutually agreed that the following terms of agreement form an integral part of the contract of booking and that no variations or modifications of this contract shall be effective unless accepted by Paul Preacher Photography in writing.

Wedding Photography Terms

•Booking Fee

An initial payment of one third of the fee is required when the client confirms the booking. Dates are only reserved when this payment is received by cheque, cash or bank transfer.

If for any reason the booking is cancelled more than four months prior to the wedding the deposit will be returned in full, between two and four months and £150 shall be returned, the full deposit is kept for cancellations less than two months prior to the wedding. Should the cancellation turn out to be a postponement, then, at the discretion of Paul Preacher Photography and subject to availability, all money may be applied to the new wedding date. In this case the total fees chargeable shall be the fee which applies at the time.

•Payments

Payment of the balance of the photography fee is to be made not later than the wedding date. Any bank charges or fees incurred due to returned cheques will be charged to the client.

•Weather

Weather permitting; the wedding photographs will be taken as agreed. In the event of adverse weather conditions, the photographers will make necessary changes in the photographic session and will not be responsible for any disappointment caused by the weather. In such circumstances the photographer with the co-operation of the client will do his best to produce coverage of the wedding within the limits of the prevailing conditions.

•Coverage

The photographer cannot be held responsible for the lack of coverage caused by the bride, the groom or wedding party not being on time, or by church, Register office, or licensed place of wedding restrictions regarding photography or anyone connected with the aforementioned. The photographer does not undertake to guarantee any specific picture nor incorporate any specific background, location or group arrangement.

•Copyright

Until final payment for services rendered is made, the photographs produced by Paul Preacher Photography are protected by Copyright Law (all rights reserved) and may not be reproduced in any manner without Paul Preacher's explicitly written permission. Upon final payment by the client, copyright ownership of the resulting images will be transferred to the client under the following conditions: The Prints, Reprints and Digital Images are the property of client for personal use and for the purposes of the reproduction and giving of photographs to friends and relatives. The Client must obtain written permission from Paul Preacher Photography prior to the client or its friends and relatives publishing or selling the photographs for profit.

•Limit of Liability

In the unlikely event that the photographer is injured or becomes too ill to photograph the event, Paul Preacher Photography will make every effort to secure a replacement photographer. If the situation should occur and a suitable replacement is not found, responsibility and liability is limited to the return of all payments received for the event package. Paul Preacher Photography takes the utmost care with respect to exposure, transportation, and processing the photographs. However, in the unlikely event that photographs have been lost, stolen, or destroyed for reasons within or beyond Paul Preacher Photography's control, Paul Preacher Photography liability is limited to the return of all payments received for the event package. The limit of liability for a partial loss of originals shall be a prorated amount of the exposures lost based on the percentage of total number of originals.

Model Release

The client hereby grants to Paul Preacher Photography and its legal representatives and assigns, the irrevocable and unrestricted right to use and publish photographs of the client or in which the client may be included, for editorial, trade or advertising purposes and in any manner and medium; to alter the same without restriction; and to copyright the same. The client hereby releases Paul Preacher Photography and its legal representatives and assigns from all claims and liability relating to said photographs.
